2.1 Passport & Visa

3.1 From Incheon (ICN) to Gimpo (GMP)

The majority of the participant's air traveling schedule will require one to land in Incheon International Airport, claim their luggage, and board the domestic line at Gimpo International Airport to depart for Busan. This means that delegates will need to travel from Incheon to Gimpo by road transportation by their own. Same goes for the schedule going back home. After departing from Busan to Gimpo, one must claim their luggage, travel to Incheon to check in for their international flights.

Since most of the participant's flights consists of multiple layovers with long flight hours and you're in the middle of a layover with strict time limits, we highly recommend taking a limousine bus that will cause you less hassle.

Although there will be a staff on site to aid you with the transfer proceedings (such as guiding you to the ticket box for the limousine bus), we highly encourage you to fully acknowledge the following information beforehand to reduce chaos or confusion.

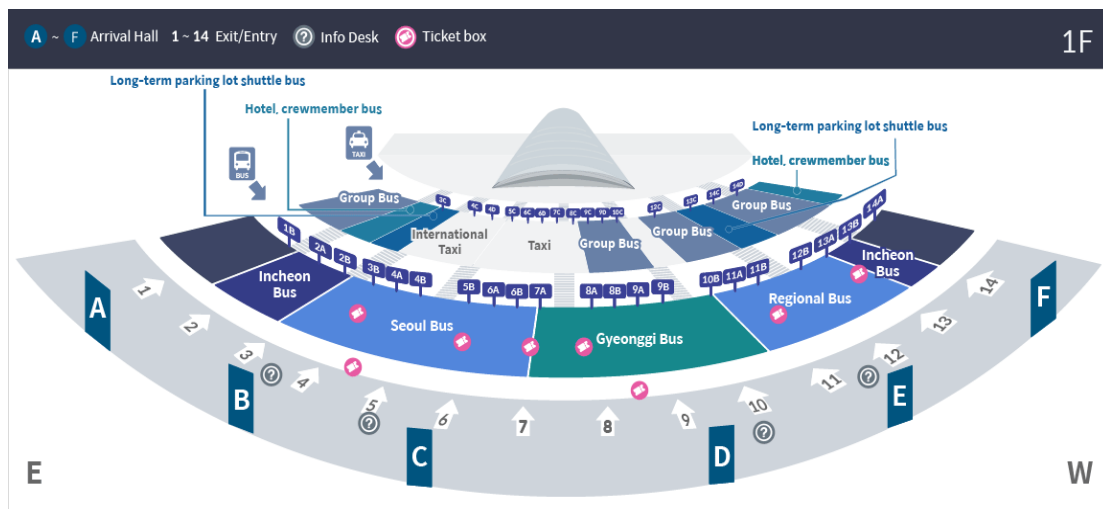

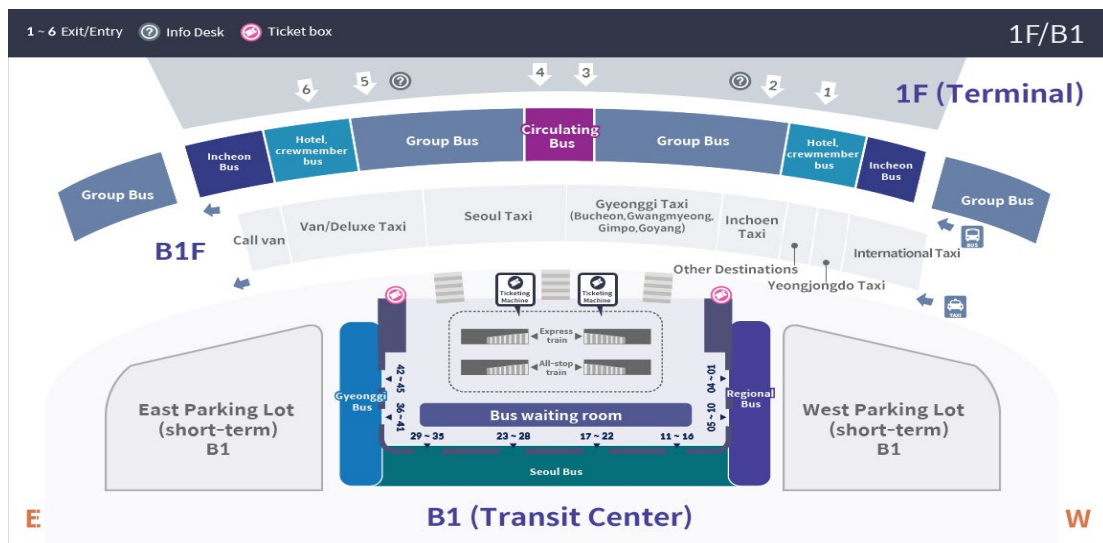
If you arrived at Terminal 1, you can take a bus at 1st floor Exit 6 or 7.

▲ Where to find ticket boxes for limousine bus at Terminal 2

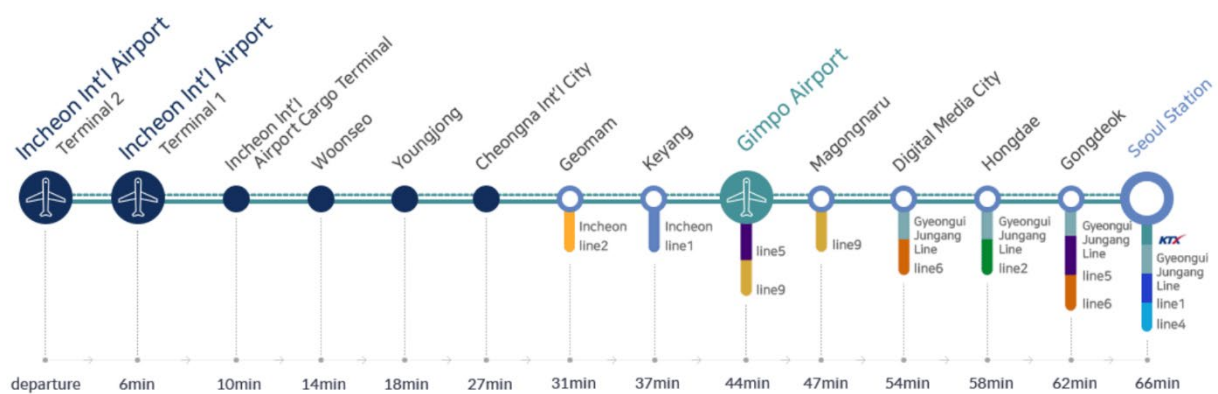
3.1.2. By AREX (Airport Express)

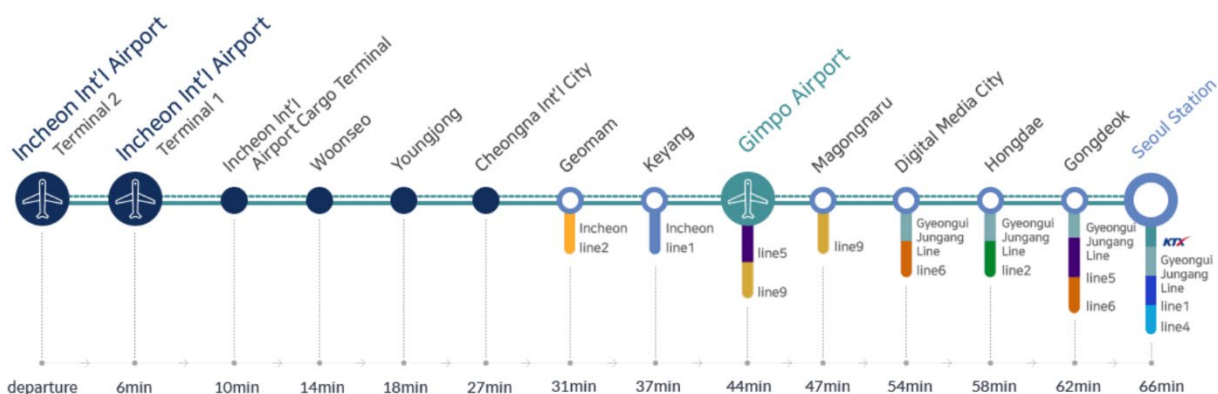

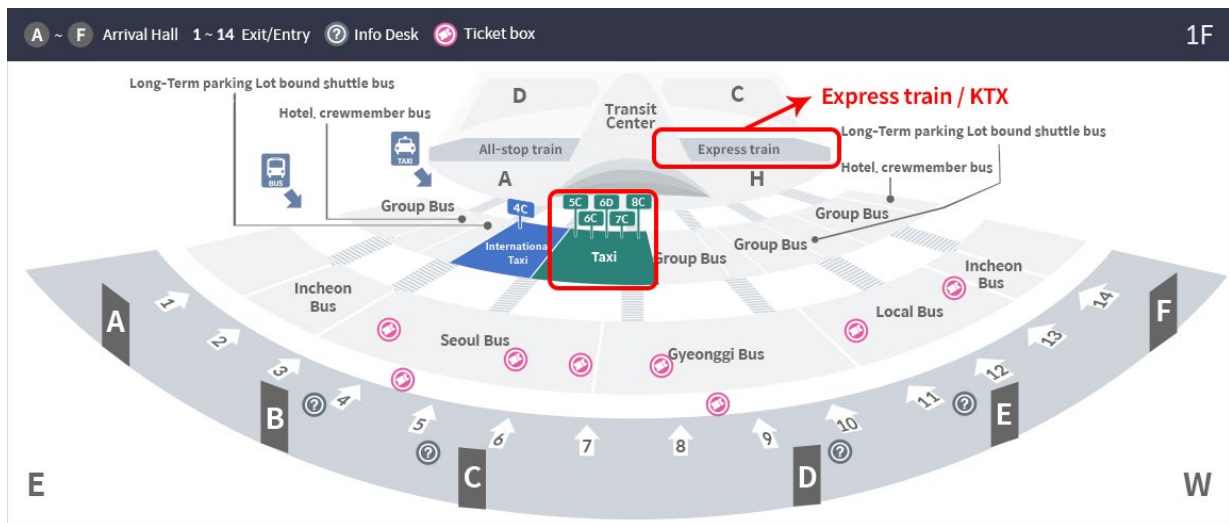


3.1.3. By Taxi

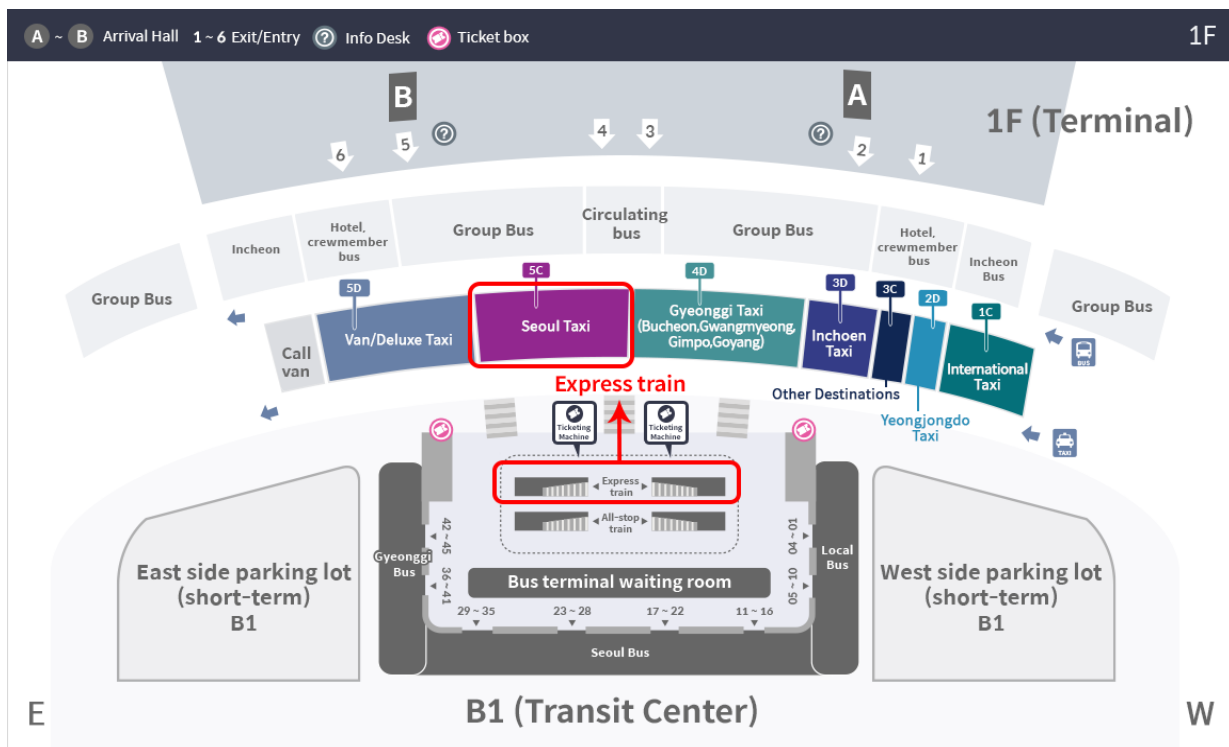
If you arrived at Terminal 1, go out through Exit 6 or 7. If you arrived at Terminal 2, go out through Exit 3 or 4. You can find Taxi Stop across the street.

Beware that *Mobum* (black car with yellow cap) taxi is more expensive due to its high-quality service, which causes the taxi fare to be three or four times higher than regular taxi (in orange, gray or yellow).

▲ Where to catch a taxi at Terminal 2

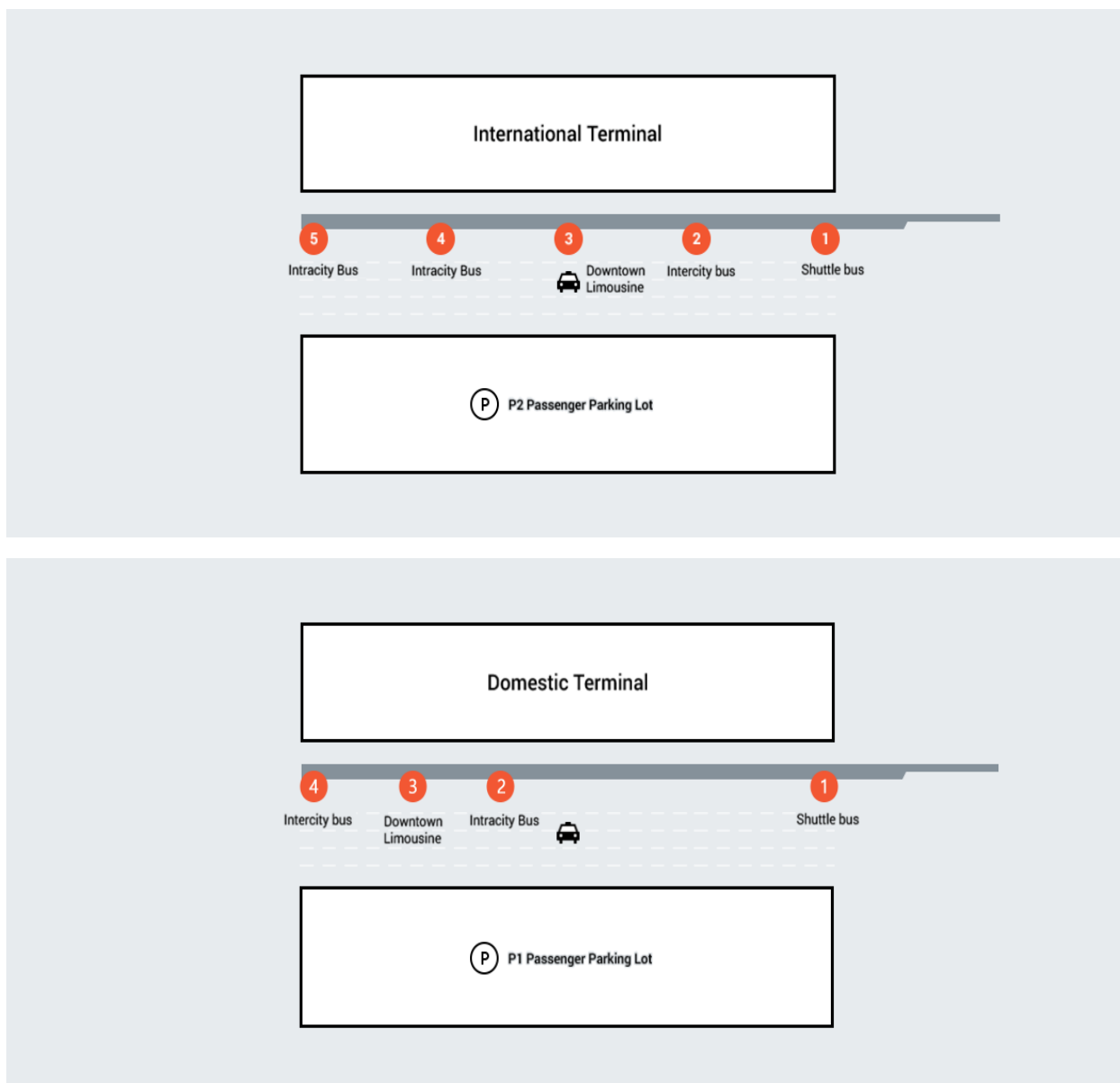
3.2 From Gimhae International Airport (Busan) to hotel

After landing at Busan Gimhae International Airport, you will need a ride from the Airport to The Westin Josun Busan (67, Dongbaek-ro, Haeundae-gu, Busan).

There are various rides available to arrive at the hotel, but we recommend using the taxi or the limousine bus.

By taxi, it will be a 50-minute drive that costs around 35,000 KRW (approx. 30 USD).

You may also take the limousine bus stopping at Westin Josun Hotel. To use the limousine bus, go to Platform 3, Floor 1, for both International and Domestic Terminals. The fare is 8,500 KRW (approx. 7 USD), and will take 70-minute. Please be aware of the 1-hour operational interval.

4. General Information

4.1 Weather in Busan (November)



The average annual temperature for autumn is 17.2 celcius. Except for the damage caused by typhoons, it tends to be sunny under the influence of the migratory anticyclones in autumn. Though Busan is warmer compared to other cities in Korea, it is recommended to bring warm clothes due to temperature differences between day and night, and the ocean breeze.

- Recommended outfit: Business casual (warm).

4.2 Currency

The unit of currency is Korean Won (KRW). 1 USD is approximately equivalent to 1,296 KRW (this may subject to change based on exchange rate). The Korean currency is called “won” (KRW). The coins in circulation include 10 KRW (embossed with an image of the Dabotap Tower), 50 KRW (embossed with an image of an ear of rice), 100 KRW (embossed with an image of Admiral Lee Sun-shin), and 500 KRW (embossed with an image of a crane). The Korean notes include the 1,000 KRW (blue), 5,000 KRW (brown), 10,000 KRW (green), and 50,000 KRW (dark yellow).

4.3 Recommended Sightseeing

4.3.1. Jagalchi Market (52 Jagalchi Haean-ro, Jung-gu, Busan)

Jagalchi Market is famous for the slogan, “Come, See, and Buy.” It is a place where you can feel the unique friendliness of Busan. A selected fish can be sliced on the spot for you to eat raw. Watching a flopping fish cleaned into sliced raw fish is in itself an amazing scene. Jagalchi Market is a must-see place for tourists.



4.3.2. BIFF Square, Busan (58-1 Gudeok-ro, Jung-gu, Busan)

In Nampodong, the “BIFF Plaza” is installed. Nampodong is one of the downtowns in Busan and is spacious enough to hold hundreds of people at once. During 2014 BIFF, a stage was set up in the heart of the “BIFF Plaza” for fans to meet movie directors and actors/actresses. However, this place is especially interesting for movie lovers because it has a movie theatre that was made for the first time in Busan, in 1934. The theatre has not been remodeled to appear more modern, so people could watch the newest films in the oldest theatre. Many people finds such history most captivating!



4.3.3. Yongdusan Park (37-55, Yongdusan-gil, Jung-gu, Busan)

The 120m high Busan Tower commands a particularly impressive view of Busan. It is also loved as a break area downtown where various programs and events are held each season. Please note that it can be easily reached by using the escalator leading to the park which was installed on Gwangbok-ro Street.



4.3.4. Lotte World Adventure Busan

Lotte World opened in OSIRIA Tourist Complex, Busan, on March 31, 2022. Lotte World Adventure Busan is decorated in warm orange tones, making you feel as if you are in a warm fairytale. Visitors can enjoy 17 rides, including Giant Digger and Giant Splash, various performances and events. As the anchor facility for the Osiria Tourism Complex, the city expects it will re-invigorate the Osiria Tourism Complex by attracting 20 million annual visitors.



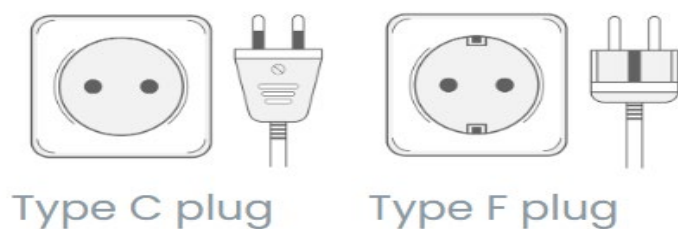
4.3.5. Use the Busan City Tour Bus

- Loop Tour and Themed Tour Departure Point: In front of Busan Station Square (between Exit 8 of Busan Metro)
- How to buy a ticket
 - Loop Tour: A Day pass for the Loop tour can be purchased from the driver at the time of boarding at each stop (first-come-first-served)
 - Themed Tour: Reservations be required in advance. A themed tour ticket can be used only once, in a single service.
- Fares (in Korean Won, KRW) / Holidays
 - Adult 15,000 KRW / Children (5 ~ HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT) 8,000 KRW
 - Group Tour (15 people or more) 2,000 KRW Discount per Person
 - ※ Holidays: No services on Mondays (Unless it is a public holiday)

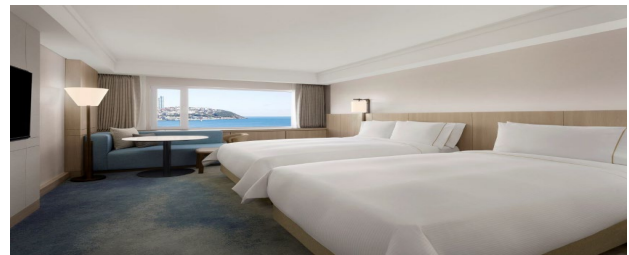
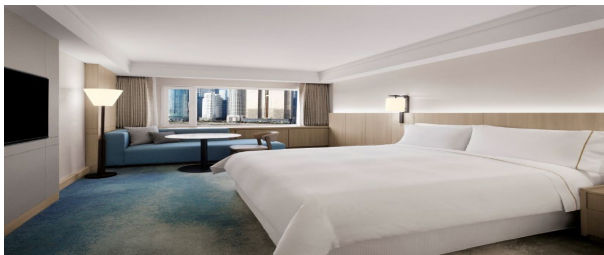


7. VENUE

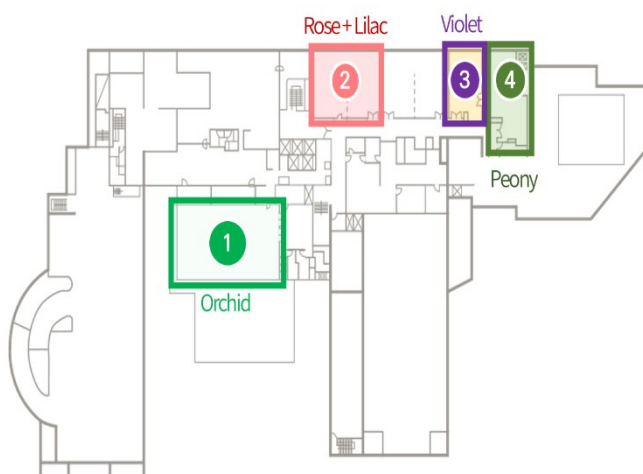
